<u>Room</u>	Action Items
Outside/Foyer	 Make sure you have a <i>new welcome mat</i> at the front door Stain the front door Add a <i>small rug for buyers to step on</i> when walking in the house (and leave their shoes) Take down the photos of the children and hang the
Living room	 Clear off the mantel Adding a print on the mantel that coordinates with the art on the wall above the couch would look lovely Roll up the area rug to show off the hardwood floors Remove the floor lamp by the fireplace and add two coordinating or matching table lamps on the two tables in the room Remove the pillows you have on the couch and add creamy and blue (possibly a throw) to match the
Dining area	 Bring up the table and chairs from the basement Add a simple centerpiece Hang a large print on the far wall A table runner can also be added if needed That is all you need in the room

Family room	 Remove the couch in front of the sliding glass doors Remove all signs of the dog Move the chair to the corner on the right (on an angle facing the gas/wood burning stove) in front of the large basket trunk Keep the lamps that you have currently <i>A large piece of art can be leaned on the mantel</i> <i>If you have a smaller side table that might work better</i> beside the chair than the one you have currently
Kitchen	 Take a leaf out of the table and leave only 4 chairs around the table for photos and showings I am questioning the area rug <i>(if we return to stage I would like to try it with the rug and without)</i> Clear off the photos and small things on the buffet <i>A print hung above it would look nice</i> The counters should have just a few decorative things on them The kitchen sink area should be clear of soaps and paper towels and anything distracting from the view of the backyard Clear off the items on the refrigerator Place the trash can in the garage You can leave the container with utensils
Half bath	 Remove anything that is on the floor <i>Add a cream staging towel and a green on the sink</i>
Mudroom	Remove all your coatsKeep only the rug at the garage door
Primary bedroom	 Add decorative pillows to your bedding Remove the small table on the side of the bed leaving only one bedside table and lamp Set up the built in decoratively with your hardback books, some décor and a green or floral Remove the fan and the weights Clear off surfaces including your jewelry (hide very well or remove all together) If possible, for photos and showings, remove the TV Clear out the tub area so that this can be set up with

Primary bathroom	 Remove anything that is on the floor Clear off personal items Use <i>fluffy towels for staging</i> In the laundry area it is fine to set up the counter as a make-up area <i>A higher chair should be added to the counter</i> <i>This room can be set up as a nice 'get ready room'</i> Put all laundry items away
Main hall bath	 Remove the valance Adding light colored bath towels is best on the towel bars The counter and inside the bath/shower should be cleared out of all personal items Remove anything that is on the floor Adding a solid cream shower curtain would be best
Bedroom #1	 Place the bed on the opposite wall Add decorative pillows
Bedroom #2	 Remove the TV and <i>add a floral on the dresser</i> Remove the desk The makeup station is fine, just minimize what is on it
Bedroom #3	 Put the closet doors back on the closet Place the desk in the nook, but with very little on it The dresser is fine Everything else should be packed up and removed from the room <i>Light colored bedding should be added to the bed with a pillow and sham and decorative pillow</i> A lamp can be placed on the dresser
Outside	• You have a beautiful outdoor entertaining area so set that up as is you were going to have a party
Misc.	 Anywhere that you can remove the valances go ahead and do so There are some that will be difficult to remove, but others should be easy if they are on the white
